Elsewhere... Good news if you have kids — there's a new Apple Seeds coming to the neighborhood. I think their "About" page is specific to their 25th Street location, but this should give you a general idea about them:

Apple Seeds is a 15,000 square foot, all-in-one play space for families with children newborn to five. We have an indoor playground designed by well known children's museum designers, over 100 classes a week — from art, to music classes like songs for seeds and Music Together, to cooking, science, construction, ballet, tap, movement, gym, soccer and language. We host weekday and weekend birthday parties, have an award winning day camp, a kids hair salon, a boutique/bookstore and cafe. We strive every moment of every day to be a safe, clean, fun place for our community to gather, socialize and play.

The Upper West Side location will be at 200 West End Avenue (between 69th & 70th). There's no official word on an opening date at the moment, but Apple Seeds is offering a \$150 discount at the new location via their homepage. Thanks to Norma, Gaby, and Jessica for the tip (that's Norma's photo).
